- 1 gallon _____ **Antiseptic Soap:** This container will be used to refill the reusable 17.5 ounce dispensers or wall dispensers. There is to be a filled hand dispenser at each handwashing facility (any station that has a sink and running water). Each home should have a minimum of three (3) 17.5 ounce reusable containers. Please buy more when your current supply is at 1/2 gallon.
- 1 can _____ **Dfen Aerosol Surface Disinfectant and Air Deodorant:** A bactericide and fungicide, this disinfects and deodorizes. Please follow label directions. Warning: Hazardous to humans and domestic animals. Use proper precautions to limit access by consumers. (NOTE: THIS PRODUCT MAY BE STORED IN A SEPARATE LOCKED LOCATION. CHECK WITH YOUR SUPERVISOR.)
- 4 bags _____ **Sani Sorb Bits:** Vomit and odor absorbent. This product is to be used to help in the collection of vomit, blood, or other spilled body fluids. Helps by absorbing liquids, making collection and disposal easier.
- 1 each 1 _____ **Brush and Waste Pan:** To be used (generally) in conjunction with the Sani Sorb Bits. When biowaste is spilled then absorbed with Sani Sorb for easy collection, it can be swept up with the brush and waste pan for disposal.
