

Visits Before Moving in to a CICL Home

During the Covid crisis additional safety steps are being taken when an individual is considering a Choices home. Here is the basic timeline:

MEET:

Individual and possible housemates should meet

- Each participant must complete a Covid-19 risk assessment before meeting
- Choose a safe place like a park or at the home in the yard
 - *Not inside the home*

TOUR:

If everyone agrees to move forward, a visit inside the home is scheduled

- Each participant must complete a Covid-19 risk assessment before entering the home,
- CICL staff will take residence on an outing during the visit to mitigate exposure
- The home manager or director will give a tour to the individual, guardian, or family member and the SSA.
- The home will be sanitized after the visit

OVERNIGHT VISIT:

If everyone agrees to move forward, an overnight visit is scheduled

- Participant must complete a Covid-19 risk assessment BEFORE entering the home
- Individual will need to bring clothing, medications, and personal items based on the length of stay. The home manager can help determine what to bring.
- Only the participant may enter the home. Family, other provider and SSA may not
- must stop at the door.

BEYOND VISITS:

If everyone agrees to move forward the SSA will schedule any needed team meetings and will work with the home manager on determining a move in date.

It is important that the new resident, family, and guardian understand CICL current policies on visits after moving in. Currently no in-home visits are schedule. Only staff of CICL and residents can enter the home. Visit can occur outside in the yard, in a safe area like a park or in the family home.
