|                               | In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code rule 5123:2-2-01 and its personnel policies, CICL, its chief executive officer, person responsible for administration, employees, contractors, and employees of contractors shall:  a) Provide services only to individuals whose needs he or she can meet. b) Provide services in a person-centered manner. c) Be able to effectively communicate with each individual receiving services. d) Be knowledgeable in the individual service plan for each individual served prior to providing services to the individual. e) Implement services in accordance with the individual service plan. f) Take all reasonable steps necessary to prevent the occurrence or recurrence of incidents adversely affecting health and safety of individuals served. g) Comply with the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code rule 5123:2-2-06. h) Arrange for substitute coverage, if necessary, only from a provider certified or approved by the Ohio Department of Developmental |

## Restrictions CICL's chief executive officer, person responsible for administration, employees, contractors, and employees of contractors of an agency provider shall not: a) Provide services to his or her minor (under age eighteen) child or his or her spouse. b) Engage in sexual conduct or have sexual contact with an individual for whom he or she is providing care. c) Administer any medication to or perform health care tasks for individuals who receive services unless he or she meets the applicable requirements of Ohio Revised Code Chapters 4723., 5123., and 5126. and rules adopted under those chapters; or d) Use or be under the influence of the following while providing services: Alcohol.
